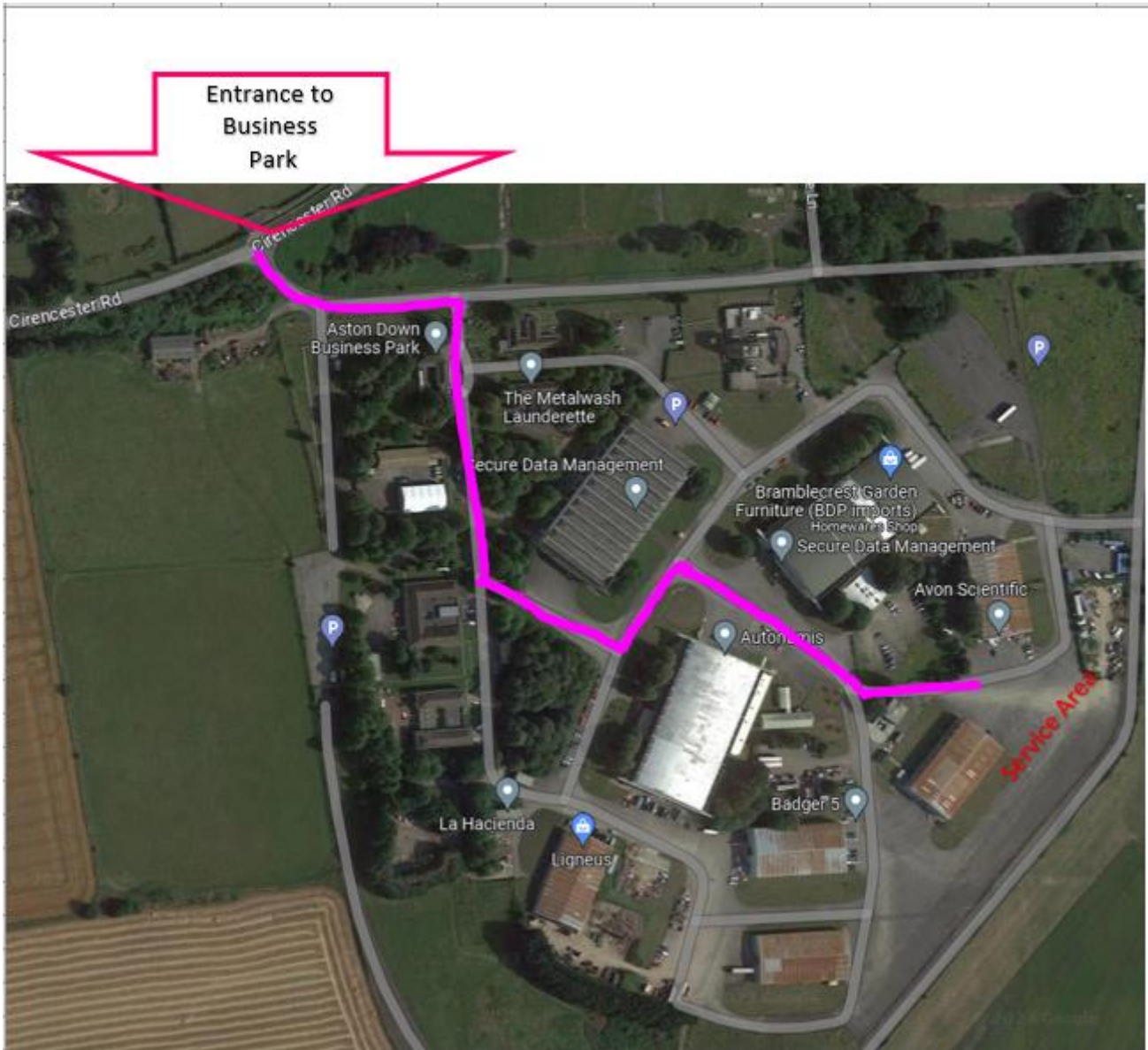
We will have a BBQ and hot drinks free of charge available to all

Programme of the Meeting

The venue will be open from 7.30am

Signing on will be in person on the venue, opens at 8.00am and must be completed by 8.45am

Scrutineering will start at 8.00am and close at 8:45am

Driver's briefing will be at 8.45am near the start.

First test will start at 09.00am, with an estimated finish about 3.30pm/4.00pm

There will NOT be a specific break for lunch.

Any competitors that are new to AutoSolo or PCA must speak to Mark Benstock for an additional briefing before commencing the competition.

Acceptance

Documents to print

All documents will be available from our web site and **you will need to print** the following before arrival at the venue:

- 2 X vehicle numbers
- Set of 3 test maps
- Please review the Entry list which will show the group you have been allocated to (A, B or C)

Documentation

You will need to provide either a physical valid Motorsport UK licence or an electronic image of a valid Motorsport UK license, minimum requirement is RS Clubman.

You will also need a valid membership card for an invited club.

Signing On

All competitors (both drivers and passengers) must sign on with our entries secretary who will be in the service area. Signing On will be open from 8.00am to 8.45am.

Only those signed on should attend on the day and spectators are not encouraged. If you have friends or family members that would like to attend, they should contact us and arrange to be a signed-on marshal.

Scrutineering

Scrutineering will take place in the service area between 8.00am and 8.45am One crew member must stay close to the competing vehicle until your car has been scrutineered in order to help us check all cars and keep to the schedule

Marshalling

In order to keep the day flowing EMCOS will supply permanent marshals if possible and we will only ask you to marshal if absolutely necessary. Please ensure you have

appropriate clothing and footwear for the expected weather conditions on the day. In lieu of limited marshalling we would be grateful if you could help us to gather up the equipment at the end of the event.

Timing & Results.

We will be using the Sapphire Solutions App to produce results which will be available on your own portable phone or device. Results will not be printed on the day. Your test times will be available immediately after you have completed each run. To access this app search on Apple Store / Android Store for Sapphire Solutions Ltd – “Timing App Live” and download to your device then select the event from the list to view results.

Penalties

As stated in the supplementary regulations there are 7 penalties listed. Contrary to Year Book M.8.1, no physical scorecard will be used. All penalties will be recorded on the sapphire app and competitors will have access to this immediately after the test has been completed.

Identification

Please print your vehicle identification numbers, they must be displayed throughout the competition on both sides of the vehicle (in a rear side window if available).

Please remove any competition numbers before leaving the venue

Litter/Spillages

Please take any litter away with you and if any fluids spill from your car please use absorption materials to clear this and again take used materials away from the venue when you leave.

Toilets, Food and Fuel

A ‘Porta-loo’ toilet will be provided.

As is customary during the season of good will there will be a complimentary food tent serving tea coffee and BBQ food from late morning to early afternoon. There will not be a lunch break, so please do visit our BBQ Chef Chris when you are on your break between tests for something warm to eat and drink.

No fuel will be available to purchase on the venue. The closest fuel station is BP Rontec on A419, approximately 5 miles from Aston Down. Please check opening times.
